

Confirmation Year 2 Commitment/Agreement 2022-23

As a Baptized Catholic, you are preparing for reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation, by which you will be more perfectly bound to the Catholic Church and enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the Faith as a witness of Christ.

I completed the 1st Year requirements in preparation to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. I am now ready to meet the following obligations in my 2nd year journey to be confirmed:

- Attend Orientation/Fall Kick-off Session with Parent/Guardian and Sponsor.
- Arrive on time to each class session (***A maximum of three (3) absences allowed throughout the year.***)
- Attend 11:00 am Mass at IC Parish with my class each Sunday.
- Select a Confirmation name by December 4, 2022 (*Must be the name of a Catholic Saint*).
- Turn in a typed history of my Saint by December 18, 2022.
- Complete 20 hours of community service by the end of February 2023.
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation during year and the week before Confirmation.
- Attend the Confirmation Year 2 weekend retreat on February 3-5, 2023.

Student promise:

- I will approach my Confirmation journey with an open mind and heart.
- I will attend and willfully participate in all class sessions and activities.
- I will show respect for other students in my class.
- I will be respectful of all leaders and facilitators of the program and show appreciation for their time and effort.

Parent/Guardian promise:

- I will encourage and support my Confirmation Candidate throughout the preparation process.
- I will attend the Parent Sessions that are scheduled throughout the year.
- I will attend Mass each Sunday and strive to be a good role model for my candidate by living according to the teachings of the Catholic Faith.
- I will pay the \$50 registration fee, (*or speak with Deacon Chavez to make payment arrangements if I am unable to pay the fee before classes begin*).

Sponsor promise:

- I will encourage and support my Confirmation Candidate throughout the year.
- I will attend the Sponsor Sessions that are scheduled throughout the year with my candidate.
- I will attend Mass each Sunday and strive to be a good role model for my candidate by living according to the teachings of the Catholic Faith.

As we make these promises, we ask God to give us the grace to be open to His plans for our life; Plans that He reveals to us in prayer, in our talents and aspirations, and in the encouragement of those who know and love us. We place ourselves in the loving embrace of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in asking for help in fulfilling this commitment.
